## PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

**Contact hours:** 72h

**Class size:** between 10 and 20 students depending on the course, usually around 15 students.

**Schedule:** classes start at 10:00 am every weekday and end at 3:00 pm. A one-hour lunch break is scheduled from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm.

**Credits:** 5 ECTS credits







Classes are divided into two parts:

- **Language classes:** morning sessions, from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. Activities focus on a language curriculum tailored to the group's level and the students' needs. At the beginning of the programme, students are assigned to a group matching their level based on the placement test.
- **Projects:** afternoon sessions, from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm. Activities are structured around a group project presented to all participants on the final day of the programme. Students participate in two projects corresponding to their level.





# Presentation of projects

You will participate in 2 projects according to your level

## Description of A1-level projects

### Project 1 - A1

#### French through rhythm and music

#### *Le français en rythme et en musique*

**Level:** A1

**Teacher:** Marion BOHY-BUNEL

**Objectives:** Discover various aspects of French music (*la chanson française*) and practice the language using selected songs that connect directly with the linguistic points covered in class during the morning sessions.

**Activities:**

- Listening to songs to train the ear (vocabulary, conjugations, rhymes, etc.).
- Watching music videos to analyze the imagery (everyday vocabulary).
- Completing or rewriting song lyrics.
- Identifying sounds and transcribing them in writing.
- Sharing opinions on the themes covered.
- Listening to instructions to perform a physical warm-up.

**Skills Developed:** Listening and reading comprehension, oral and written production, oral interaction + rhythm and intonation.

**Final Output:** A collective performance (or individual on a voluntary basis) of a song (Oral Production) after rewriting the lyrics in class (Written Production).

**Assessment Criteria:** Level of engagement and commitment in preparing the final song performance.



## Project 2 - A1

### Lives of people of Lyon: Meeting the Locals and Exploring the City

#### *Vies lyonnaises : à la rencontre des habitants et des lieux*

**Level:** A1

**Teacher:** Nuri BAEZ PEREZ

**Objectives:**

- Discover Lyon.
- Go out and meet the local people (*Les Lyonnais*).
- Be in direct contact with the city and its residents.

**Activities:**

- **In Class:**
  1. Choosing the topics to explore (gastronomy, history, iconic landmarks, etc.).
  2. Designing observation questionnaires.
  3. Sharing experiences.
  4. Creating the final presentations (poster or PowerPoint to summarize discoveries made during field trips).
- **Outside the Classroom:**

Gathering information from locals and across the city using the questionnaires designed in class.

**Skills Developed:** Listening comprehension, oral expression, written expression, reading comprehension.

**Final Output:** A poster or PowerPoint presentation summarizing the discoveries made during the field trips (combining text and photos).

**Assessment Criteria:**

- A grade for participation, investment, and progress.
- A grade for the final presentation.



## Description of A2-level projects

### Project 1 - A2

#### Discovering Lyon and its inhabitants

#### *À la découverte de Lyon et des lyonnais*

**Level:** A2

**Teacher:** Julie STAUBER

**Objectives:** By the end of the course, you will be able to:

- Talk about a city.
- Navigate/find your way around a city.
- Ask questions to native speakers.
- Chat with native speakers.
- Get to know the habits of Lyon's locals better.
- Give oral presentations.
- Write an interview article.

**Activities:**

Surveys on campus, in the university neighborhood, and around the city. Discovery trails and classroom discussions using a variety of materials.

**Skills Required:**

All skills: listening to audio documents, watching videos about the city, reading texts about the city, questionnaires, and discovery trails.

- **Speaking:** Presenting your final work orally.
- **Writing:** Writing the articles for the magazine.

**Final Product:**

A magazine about life in Lyon.

**Assessment Criteria:**

- A grade for participation and engagement (25%).
- A grade for the various oral presentations in class (25%).
- A grade for the various written assignments (50%).



## Project 2 - A2

### Lyon and its Gastronomy

*Lyon et sa gastronomie*

**Level:** A2

**Teacher:** Cathy NGUYEN

**Objectives:**

- Discover Lyon's gastronomic culture.
- Discover Lyon's culinary specialties and the regions of France.
- Present a French-speaking chef.
- Write a restaurant review.
- Understand authentic documents (menus, recipes, restaurant reviews).

**Proposed Activities:**

- Role-playing games: Ordering at a restaurant.
- Reading a menu, a recipe, and a review.
- Presentation on French specialties and their regions.
- Presenting an original restaurant concept.
- Food-themed "Time's Up!" game.

**Skills Required:**

- Reading Comprehension: Menus, recipes, reviews.
- Listening Comprehension: Reports, radio clips, cooking recipe podcasts.
- Speaking: Role-plays, presentation on a chef.
- Writing: Restaurant review, presenting a region and its specialties.
- Final Product:

Writing a Lyon gastronomic guide (in groups) featuring several locations and typical dishes, accompanied by an oral presentation.

**Assessment Criteria:**

25% for each of the four skills: listening comprehension, reading comprehension, speaking, and writing.



## Description of B1-level projects

### Project 1 - B1 The CIEF Gazette *La Gazette du CIEF*

**Level:** B1

**Teacher:** Sylvia ESPINOSA

**Main Objectives:**

- Discover and engage with the cultural news and events of the city of Lyon.
- Write articles and share experiences in a newspaper/journal.
- Practice spoken and written French both inside and outside the classroom.
- Work as a team.
- Consolidate core language skills by reviewing the interrogative form, past tenses, time markers, comparisons, relative pronouns, emphasis (la mise en relief), direct and indirect speech, etc.

**Proposed Activities:**

*Online or outside-the-classroom activities:*

- Online questionnaires.
- Writing a collaborative editorial.
- Listening to and reporting on testimonials/interviews.
- Narrating a travel experience.
- Interviewing native speakers.

**Skills Required:**

Listening comprehension, reading comprehension, speaking, and writing.

**Type of Final Product:**

An oral presentation of the project and the distribution of the gazette to the other students of the programme. The gazette will chronicle the experiences lived during these 4 weeks (including interviews, travel and discovery stories, photo reports, etc.).

**Assessment Criteria:**

- A grade for active participation in activities and events.
- A grade for the quality of the written work.



**Project 2 - B1**  
**Lyon, City of cinema**  
*Lyon, ville de cinéma*

**Level:** B1

**Teacher:** Nuri BAEZ-PEREZ

**Objectives:**

- Discover Lyon through cinema and film shooting locations.
- Observe and compare real locations with their representation in movies.
- Describe a place and express a personal opinion.
- Create a captioned photo exhibition about the locations visited.

**Proposed Activities:**

**In class:**

- Listening comprehension based on scenes from movies filmed in Lyon.
- Reading comprehension activities focused on movie synopses and documents about Lyon and cinema.
- Observation and analysis of the locations featured in the films.
- Sharing impressions and comparing film scenes with the actual real-life locations.
- Writing personal captions/commentaries for the photo exhibition.

**Outside the classroom:**

- Visiting film shooting locations in Lyon.
- Observing, taking notes, and taking photos for the final exhibition.

**Skills Required:**

Listening comprehension - Speaking - Writing - Reading comprehension.

**Final Product:**

A captioned photo exhibition (photos of the locations and comparisons with the movie scenes).

**Assessment Criteria:**

- A grade for engagement and progress.
- A grade for the final product.



## Description of B2-level projects

### Project 1- B2 Lyon, Historic city *Lyon ville historique*

**Level:** B2

**Teacher:** Samia AOUDIA

**Objectives:**

- Discover the city of Lyon through different periods of its history.
- Participate in guided tours of the city's iconic landmarks and give an oral report on them.
- Understand authentic audio, video, and written materials.

**Activities:**

- Guided tours of the Lugdunum Museum and the Montluc Prison National Memorial.
- Research project on the general chronological history of Lyon.
- Daily life in Lugdunum during the Gallo-Roman era.
- Treasure hunt / scavenger hunt in Old Lyon (*Vieux Lyon*), weather permitting.
- Lyon as a city of the Resistance during World War II.

**Skills Required:**

Listening and reading comprehension, speaking and writing.

**Final Product:**

Choose a period of Lyon's history to present in groups for 10-15 minutes. This can take the form of an exhibition, a video, a short theatrical skit, a song, a PowerPoint presentation, etc.

**Assessment Criteria:**

- A grade for participation.
- A grade evaluating the final group project.



## Projet 2 - B2

### Humour, the French way

#### *Humour à la française*

**Level:** B2

**Teacher:** Magalie DUCHESNE

#### **Objectives:**

In this course, you will...

- Discover examples of French humor in commercials, comedy sketches, and clips from TV series and movies.
- Develop your speaking, writing, listening, and reading skills.
- Improve your pronunciation.

#### **Proposed Activities:**

- Video-based coursework: Analyzing and understanding commercials, sketch clips, and films.
- Discovering comedians.
- Discovering *cafés-théâtres* (comedy clubs) in Lyon and meeting a comedian.
- Creative writing: Imagining a sequel/continuation, creating a dialogue, writing a script.
- Speaking: Expressing your opinion / Role-playing / Acting out a scene / Conducting an interview.

#### **Skills Required:**

- **Listening Comprehension:** Understanding video materials.
- **Speaking:** Expressing your opinion, imagining a sequel, acting out a scene, conducting an interview, etc.
- **Writing:** Creating a dialogue, writing a script.

#### **Final Product:**

Making a funny/humorous video.

#### **Assessment Criteria:**

- The writing of a script.
- The production of the video (direction/staging, language skills (grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation)).



## Description of C1-levels projects

### Project 1 - C1 Lyon, Artistic City *Lyon ville artistique*

**Level:** C1

**Teacher:** Sylvie ROBERT

**Main Objectives:** Discovery of the city's artistic heritage.

**Activities:**

Classroom sessions and *in situ* (on-site) learning.

- The course will serve as a journey through time, from the Roman era to contemporary times.
- Lugdunum.
- The Italian heritage.
- Discovering architectural heritage (fountains, decorative elements on facades: caryatids, atlantes, etc.), *traboules*, and *miraboules* (hidden courtyard passageways).
- The painted walls / murals (Croix-Rousse, Tony Garnier, Diego Rivera).
- Contemporary urban art.

**Skills Required:**

- **Speaking:** Oral presentations (research / artwork descriptions / interactions with native speakers).
- **Writing:** Questionnaires, writing reflective feedback on the visits undertaken.
- **Reading and Listening Comprehension:** Corpus analysis (interviews, articles).

**Final Product:**

An oral presentation (individual or in pairs, depending on class size).

**Assessment Criteria:**

Average grade calculated from 2 or 3 scores:

- 2 assessments / 10
- 1 final oral presentation



**Project 2 - C1**  
**Lyon Through Its Discoveries**  
*Lyon à travers ses découvertes*

**Level:** C1/C2

**Teacher:** Patrice AROKEUM

**Objectives:** Discover inventions, culture, and industries originating from Lyon.

**Activities:**

Research / Visits / Surveys.

**Skills Required:**

Listening and reading comprehension, speaking and writing.

**Final Product:**

An oral presentation and display (poster and description): presenting a Lyonnais invention that you will have chosen at the beginning of the programme.

**Assessment Criteria:**

- A grade for the oral presentation.
- A grade for the poster.

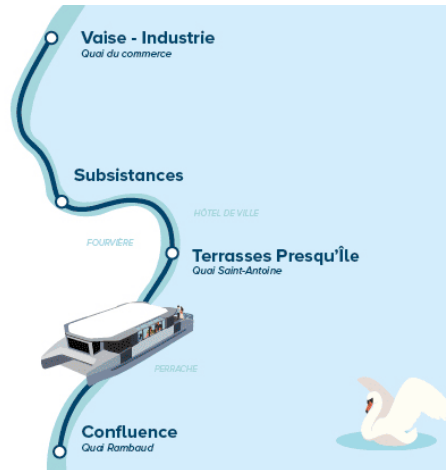

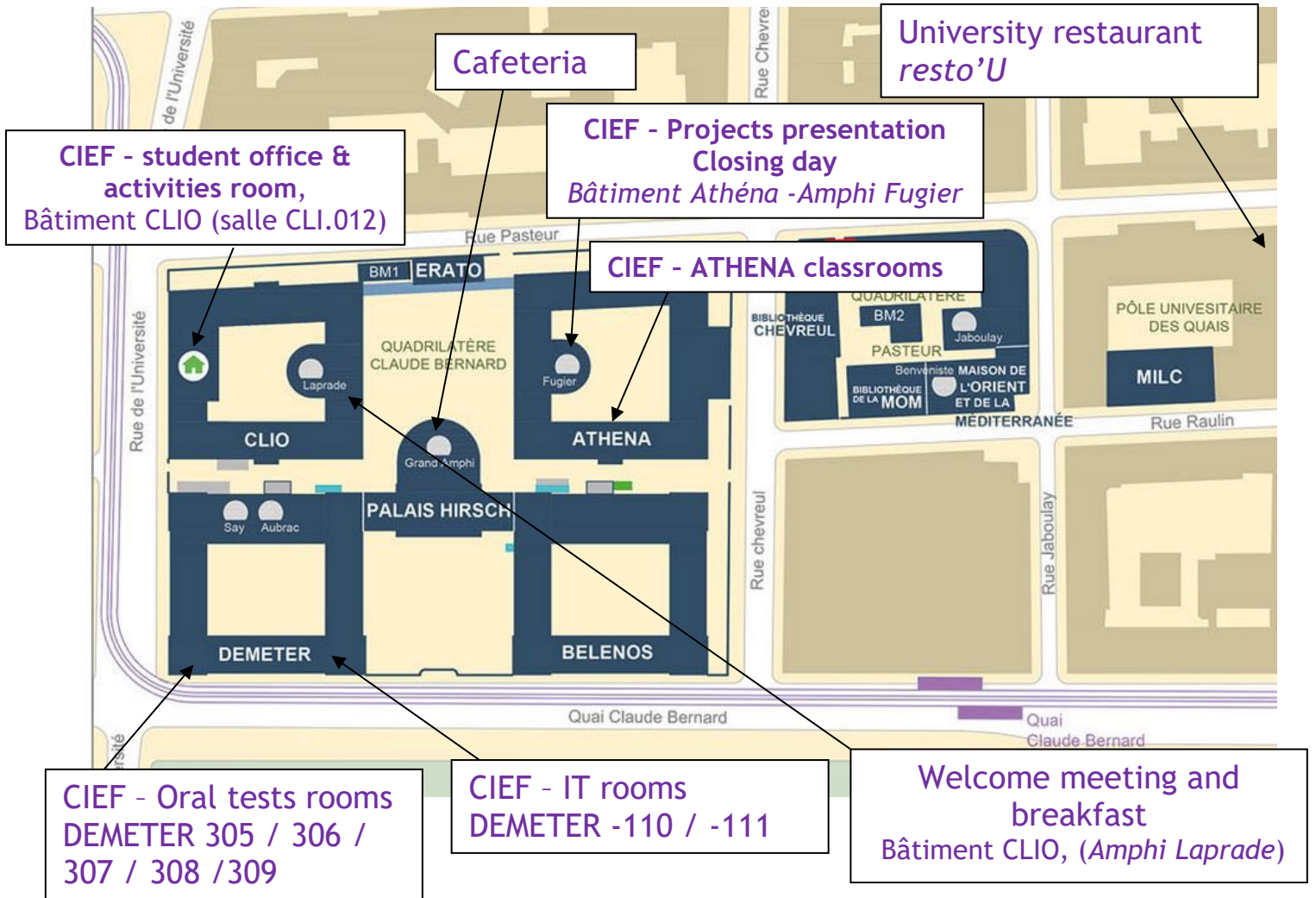
